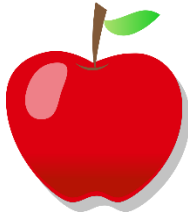




Chamberlayne Elementary School Supply List 2020-2021 **Virtual Start**

Below is the list of basic supplies for each grade level. Please remember that supplies may need to be replenished throughout the school year.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic school box • 1 bottle Elmer's glue • 1 pack of glue sticks • 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count) • 12 sharpened #2 pencils- primary pencils that are thicker are easier for them to use at the beginning of the year. • 1 box of Ziploc sandwich bags for organizing sorting cards. • 1 pair of Fiskar scissors • 2 black and white marble composition notebooks • 4 - pack of Dry Erase Markers • Eraser which could be an old cloth or sock from home. • Small dry erase board (if possible 1 side lined and 1 side blank) available at the Dollar Store. If you can't find a dry erase board, you can put a piece of white cardstock paper inside a plastic sleeve. • 2 - pink erasers • 1 - pencil sharpener your child can use independently. <p><u>Dollar store items that will help us make learning hands-on at home.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • dice • popsicle sticks • one small container of playdough • magnetic letters- uppercase and lowercase • sight word cards • pack of construction paper <p>Recommended: Creating a learning space at home that can be used to organize materials while we learn virtually. Students should be able to access materials during lessons.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 large pencil box- regular not one with a lock • 1 box of 24 count Crayola crayons • 1 pair of metal child's scissors (Fiskar is preferred) • 1 pink erasers • 12 sharpened #2 pencils • 1 pack of glue sticks • 4 black and white composition notebooks • 1 spiral notebook • 1 pack of black dry erase markers • Dry erase board eraser (Ideas for expo erasers-sock, towel, felt) • Small dry erase board (if possible 1 side lined and 1 side blank) available at the Dollar Store. If you can't find a dry erase board, you can put a piece of white cardstock paper inside a plastic sleeve. • 1 pencil sharpener your child can use independently • 1 pack of multi-colored construction paper • 1-3 tubs of Play Doh • Optional but recommended: small magnetic, plastic, or foam letters <p>Recommended: A bag, box, or container to keep all school supplies. Store in a location that is easy for your child to access independently for virtual learning/meetings.</p> <p>**Fill the pencil case with: 1 box of Crayola crayons, scissors, 5 sharpened pencils, 1 pink eraser, 3-4 glue sticks, 2 dry erase markers, 1 pencil sharpener</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 pencil bag (gallon ziploc bag will work) • 1 box of crayons • 1 pack of pencils (sharpened) • 1 pack of pink erasers • 1 pair of scissors • 1 pack of glue sticks • 1 1-inch 3 ring binder • 1 pack of wide ruled notebook paper • 1 five pack of tab dividers (please label reading, math, science, social studies, and writing) • 1 small white board (if possible 1 side lined and 1 side blank) available at the Dollar Store • 1 pack of expo markers (Ideas for expo erasers-sock, towel, felt) <p>Recommended: A bag, box, or container to keep all school supplies. Store in a location that is easy for your child to access independently for virtual learning/meetings.</p>

Store in a location that is easy for your child to access independently for virtual learning/meetings.</p> <p>**Fill the pencil case with: 1 box of crayons, colored pencils, scissors, 5 sharpened pencils, 1 pink eraser, 2-3 glue sticks, 2 dry erase markers, 1 pencil sharpener, 1 highlighter</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 small glue sticks, no liquid glue • 1 pair of scissors • 1 pack of yellow #2 pencils • 1 pencil sharpener • 1 box of colored pencils • 1 box of crayons • 5 composition notebooks (preferred colors: yellow, red, green, blue, and black) NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS • Headphones • 1 small dry erase board • 1 pack of dry erase markers • 1 zipper pencil pouch or plastic pencil box • 2 highlighters • 2 red ink pens • 3-- 2 pocket folders, plastic please with holes for binder • 1 pack of Post-Its notes • 1 pack of index cards • 1-Ruler (inches/centimeters) • 1 ½ inch binder (white) <p>Composition Notebooks will be used for Interactive notes. Colors will be for specific subjects.</p> <p>Suggestion: Bookbag (old or new) to keep all composition notebooks, folders and tools to keep all materials together. Store in a location that is easy for your child to access independently for virtual learning/meetings.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3, 1 subject spiral notebooks • 1 pack loose-leaf paper • 1, 2-pocket folders (plastic only please) • 1- three hole zipper pencil pouch (no plastic pencil boxes please) • 1 pack of colored pencils (no markers) • 1 pack of red pens • 1 pack of Expo markers • 1 pack of index cards • 1 pair of scissors • 1 pack of highlighters • 6 glue sticks • 1 pack of pencils (no mechanical pencils) • 1 box of cap erasers • 1 pair of headphones • 1 small white erase board (available at Dollar Tree) <p align="center">*Notebook quantities are mandatory. All other school supply quantities are up to family discretion.</p> <p>Recommended: A bag, box, or container to keep all school supplies.
